IN THE YEAR 2020, WE PROVIDED
COMPREHENSIVE CASE
MANAGEMENT TO 134 FAMILIES AT RISK OF
HOMELESSNESS, OF WHOM 96% OBTAINED
SAFE AND STABLE HOUSING.



PUBLIC SAFETY

BUILDING A STRONG NETWORK OF SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL SUPPORTS TO PREVENT VIOLENCE

OF THE GANG-AFFECTED YOUTH WHO WE
HAVE SERVED IN THE FIRST SIX MONTHS OF
2020, 75% HAVE SHOWN A REDUCTION IN
RISK FACTORS OR AN INCREASE IN
PROTECTIVE FACTORS.

Our Collective Impact

IN THE YEAR OF 2020, BPNN PARTNERS HAVE:

- OFFERED AFTER-SCHOOL ENRICHMENT AND ACADEMIC SUPPORT PROGRAMMING TO 1,958 BRIGHTON PARK STUDENTS, OF WHOM MORE THAN HALF (52%) DEMONSTRATED IMPROVED ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT.
- FACILITATED ACCESS TO HEALTH PROMOTING RESOURCES AND OPPORTUNITIES, WITH A TOTAL OF 7,409 INDIVIDUAL VIEWED OUR VIRTUAL HEALTH WORKSHOPS, 223 COMMUNITY MEMBERS ENROLLING IN MEDICAID INSURANCE COVERAGE, AND 226 STUDENTS AND ADULTS TAKING PART IN SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY-BASED MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING SERVICES.
- PROVIDED OVER \$1.2 MILLION IN EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO MORE THAN 850 FAMILIES WHOSE EMPLOYMENT SITUATION WAS NEGATIVELY AFFECTED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC, THUS OFFERING CRITICAL FINANCIAL SUPPORT IN THE MIDST OF A GLOBAL HEALTH CRISIS.
- CONNECTED 75 YOUTH WITH SUMMER EMPLOYMENT AND CASE MANAGEMENT SUPPORT, WITH 97% OF YOUTH PARTICIPANTS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETING THE SUMMER EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM.
